

SCAUG Map Gallery Contest Official Rules

The goal of the Map Gallery Contest is to educate SCAUG members about new and effective ways of using GIS. At no time is a participant in the Map Gallery Contest allowed to use his/her entry to advertise or promote a product, service, or company.

This rule will be strictly enforced! Participation in the Map Gallery Contest must be by the individual author, developer, or team responsible for the creation and development of the original map. Maps must be such that they are not exhibited for purposes of sale or purchase in any form.

Contestants limited to 3 entries.

Except where prohibited, participation in the SCAUG Map Gallery Contest constitutes contestant's consent for SCAUG to use his/her name, likeness, voice, opinions, country of residence, and performance results for promotional purposes in any media without payment or consideration. As a condition of award acceptance, all winners agree to allow SCAUG to publish his/her name and organization's name and a description of the work on the SCAUG Web site, as well as in all mediums of communication now known or later developed.

By submitting maps, contestants agree that all work is original and has been independently produced. Any submissions that are not produced by contestant or violate copyright, patent, or trade secret laws are ineligible. Any entry that does not comply will be disqualified.

ALL CONTESTANTS CLAIM OWNERSHIP OF ANY MAPS SUBMITTED AND AGREE TO HOLD SCAUG HARMLESS FOR ANY CLAIMS OF OWNERSHIP OR RIGHTS TO THE MAPS BY THIRD PARTIES. CONTESTANT AGREES TO DEFEND, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS SCAUG FROM AND AGAINST ANY LOSS, LIABILITY, COST, OR EXPENSE, INCLUDING REASONABLE ATTORNEYS' FEES, WHICH MAY BE INCURRED BY LICENSEE AGAINST ANY CLAIMS, ACTIONS, OR DEMANDS BY A THIRD PARTY ALLEGING THAT THE MAP INFRINGES THE RIGHTS OF A LEGITIMATE U.S. PATENT, COPYRIGHT, TRADE SECRET, OR TRADEMARK. SCAUG RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DISCONTINUE THE CHALLENGE WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE OR TO NOT GRANT ANY AWARDS IF THE SUBMITTED ENTRIES DO NOT MEET THE CRITERIA SET FORTH HEREIN. ALL JUDGING IS FINAL AND IS NOT SUBJECT TO APPEAL.
