 - Recruiting of employees






Commuting to the Industrial Park and to the **City of Claremore**

Comparison of Commuting Destinations




Commuting by County of Residence


Home County Comparison

Claremore Industrial Park Commuters by Home County


Claremore Commuters by Home County



Park Commuters by Home County




Commuter Density by Home County




Commute Time Comparisons

Park Worker Drive Times




Note: time ranges are exhaustive. For example, 0-14 minutes means anything less than 15 minutes.

Industrial Park vs. Rogers Co., Tulsa Co., & U.S.




Commuters by City
