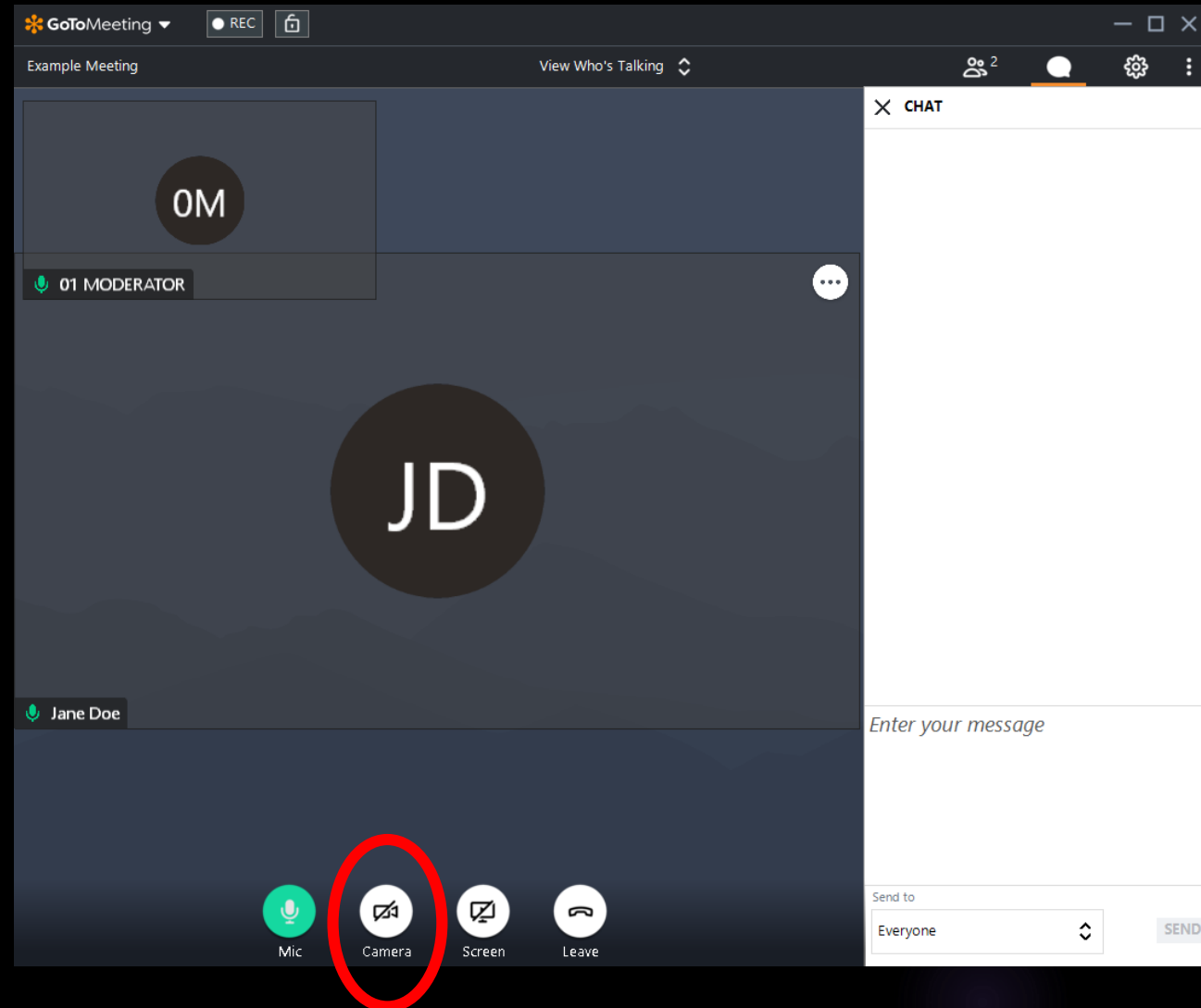
Enter Your Name in GoToMeeting

- ▶ GoToMeeting should prompt you to enter your name when you enter the meeting, but if it doesn't...
- ▶ Click the 3 little dots on your rectangle in the meeting
- ▶ Select "Edit Your Name and Email"
- ▶ **Attendees**, please put your First AND Last name in the Name spot. You may also put your organization if you'd like.
- ▶ **Exhibitor- & Sponsor-affiliated attendees**, please put "(EXHIBITOR: your company)" or "(SPONSOR: your company)" after your name and an asterisk * before your name so you show up at the top of the Room chat so people can find you easily



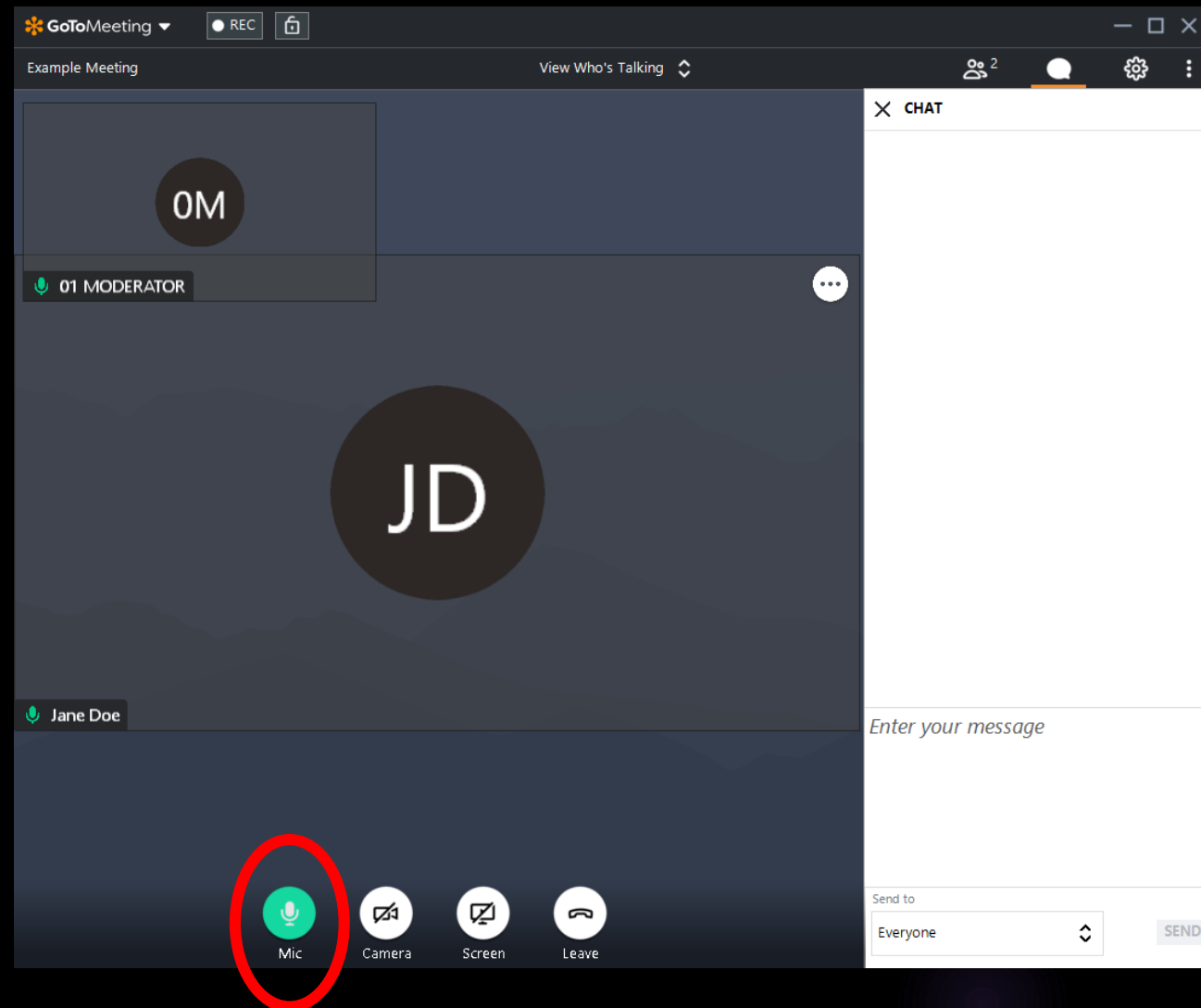
Video On/Off in GoToMeeting

- ▶ Please leave your video off during presentations. Having too many webcams on at once causes problems.
- ▶ You may turn your webcam on when asked, to present, to ask questions, and to chat on breaks.



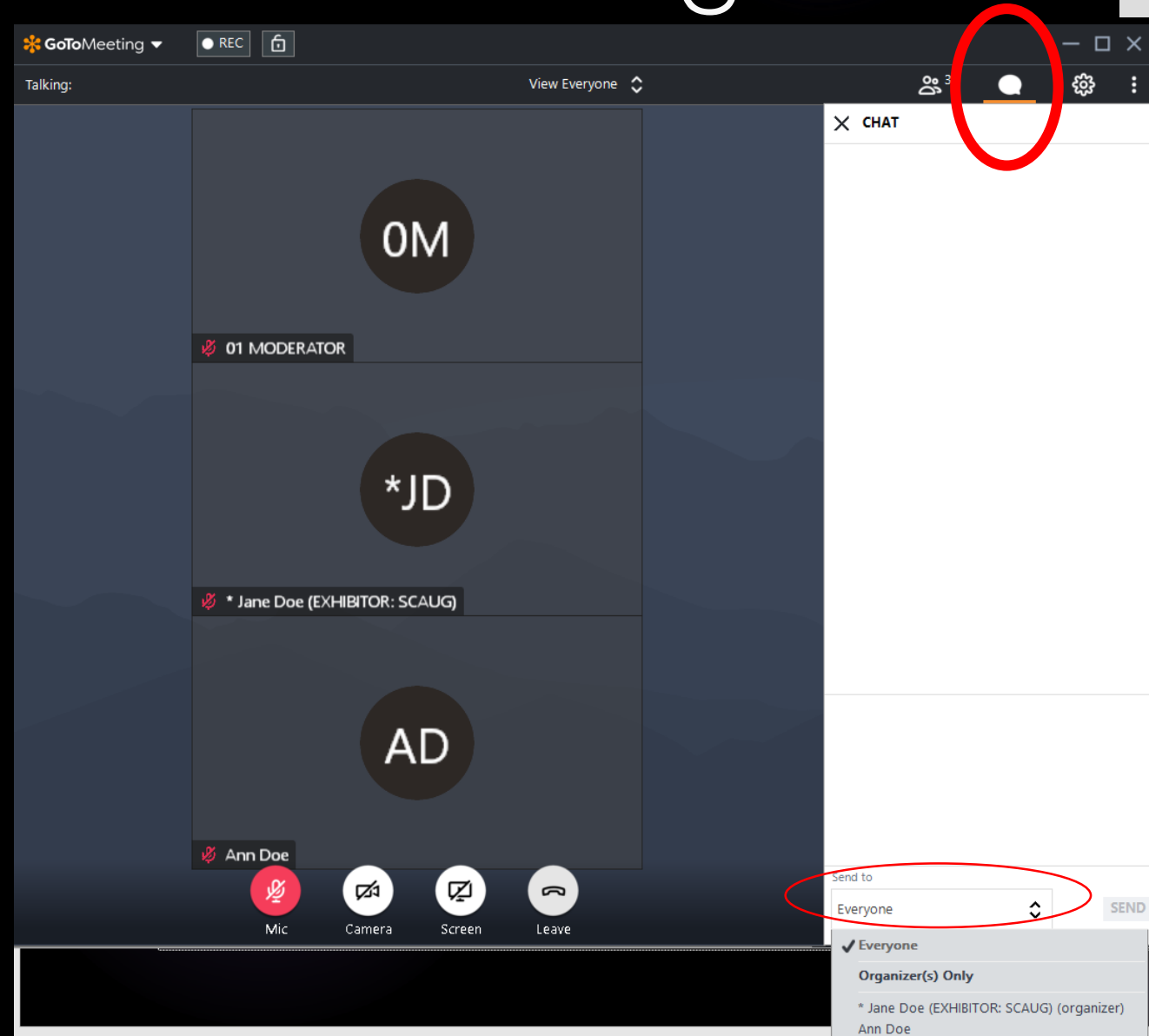
Mute/Unmute in GoToMeeting

- ▶ Please stay muted during presentations. Being unmuted causes distracting background noise.
- ▶ You may turn your mic on when asked, to present, to ask questions, and to chat on breaks.



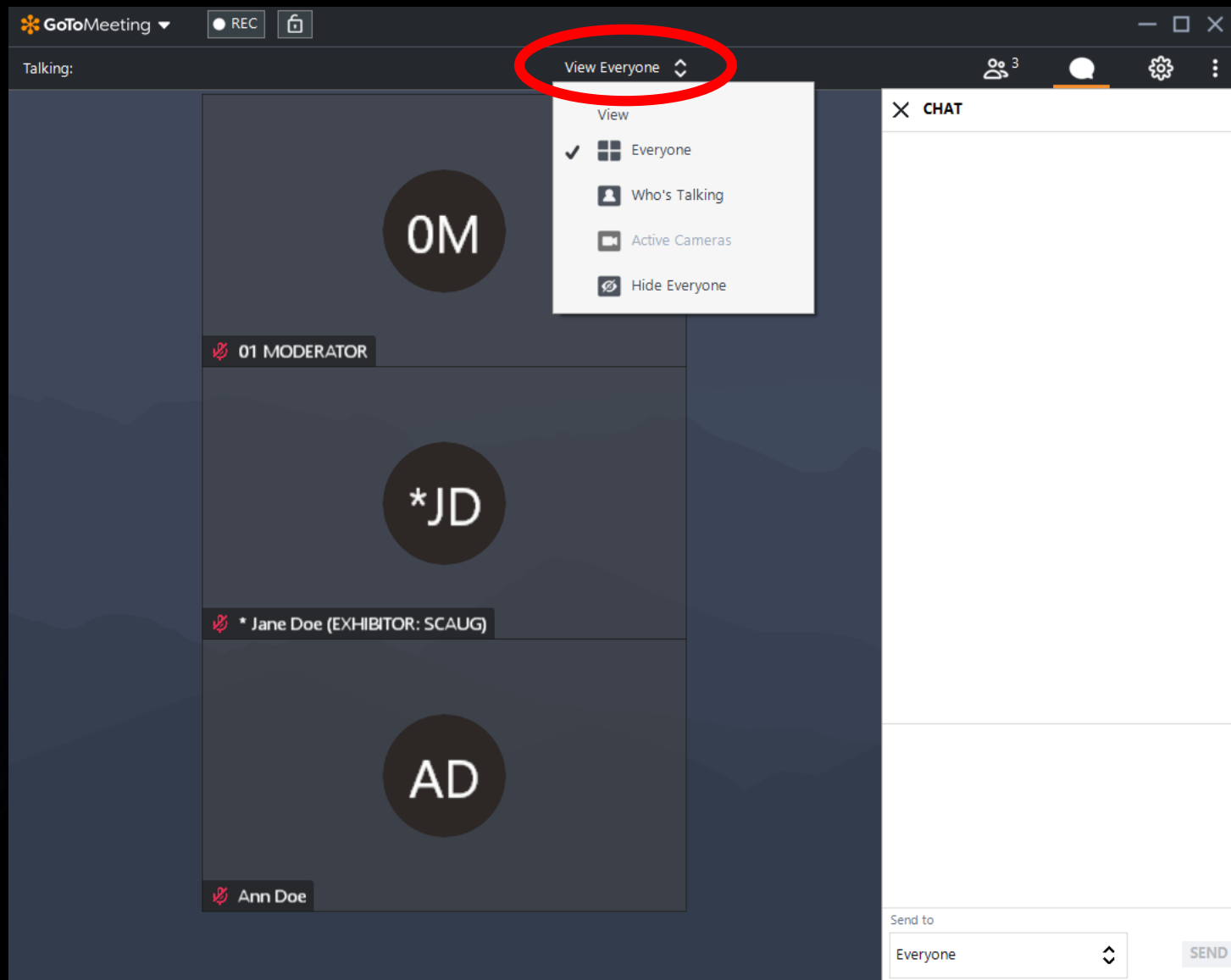
Use the Chat in GoToMeeting

- ▶ Click the little white speech bubble to make the chat window appear/disappear
- ▶ Select who you would like to send a chat to in the dropdown menu at the bottom
- ▶ You can send messages to Everyone, Organizers only, or individuals
- ▶ If you would like to send a chat just to the moderator, find “01 MODERATOR”, “02 MODERATOR”, or “03 MODERATOR” depending on the Room # you are in
- ▶ If you would like to send a chat to OKSCAUG Tech Support, please find “00 OKSCAUG SUPPORT” in the chat



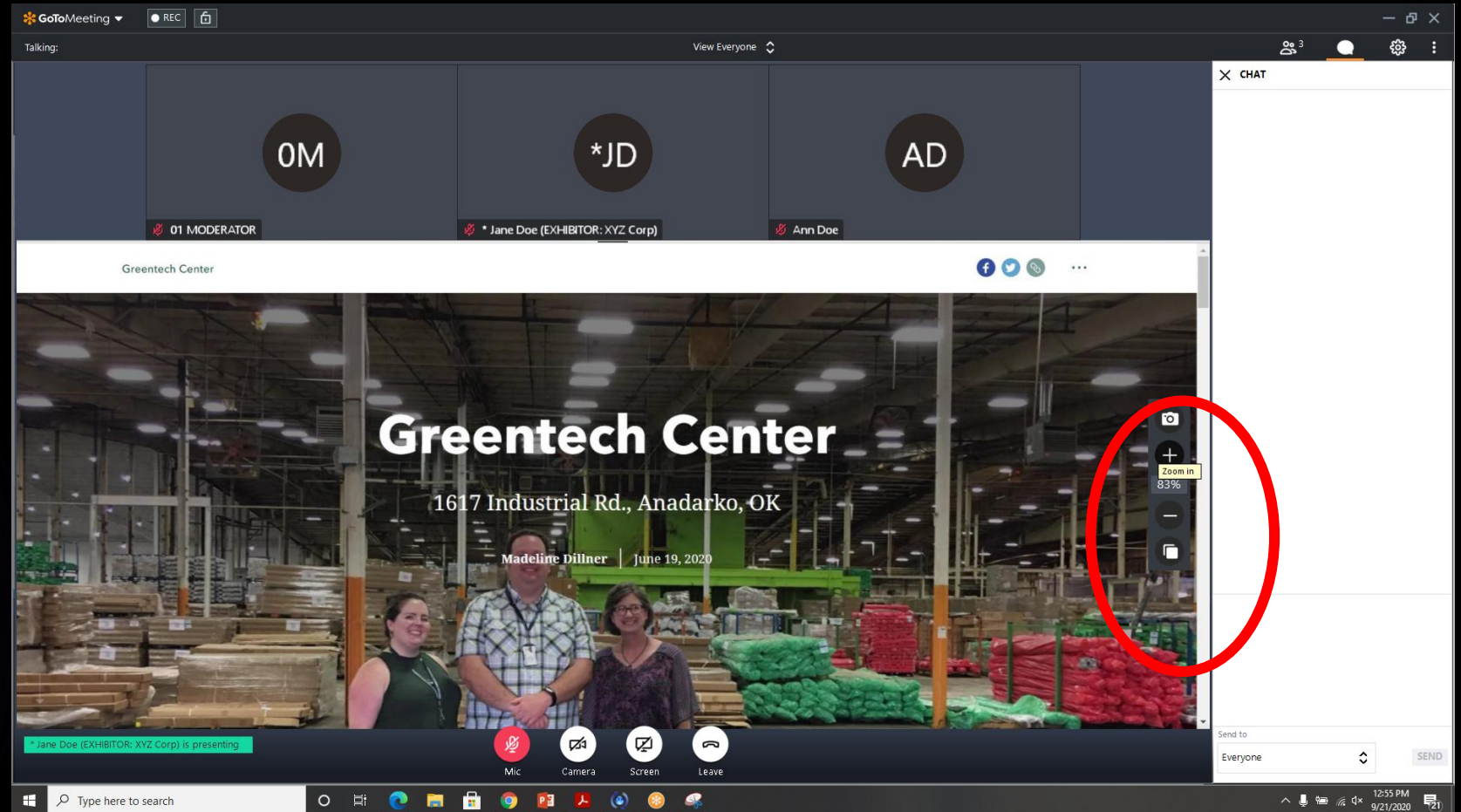
Change View in GoToMeeting

- ▶ **View Everyone** to see everyone's rectangles on the screen, regardless of webcam status
- ▶ **View Who's Talking** to see who's not muted...
- ▶ **View Active Cameras** for a cool effect during the Orientation Games when we ask groups of you to turn your cameras on all at once
- ▶ **Hide Everyone** if you only want to see the presenter's screen and no faces



Screen Zoom in GoToMeeting

- ▶ If the text on someone's presentation is too small, jiggle your mouse over their shared screen and the Zoom In/Zoom Out options should appear

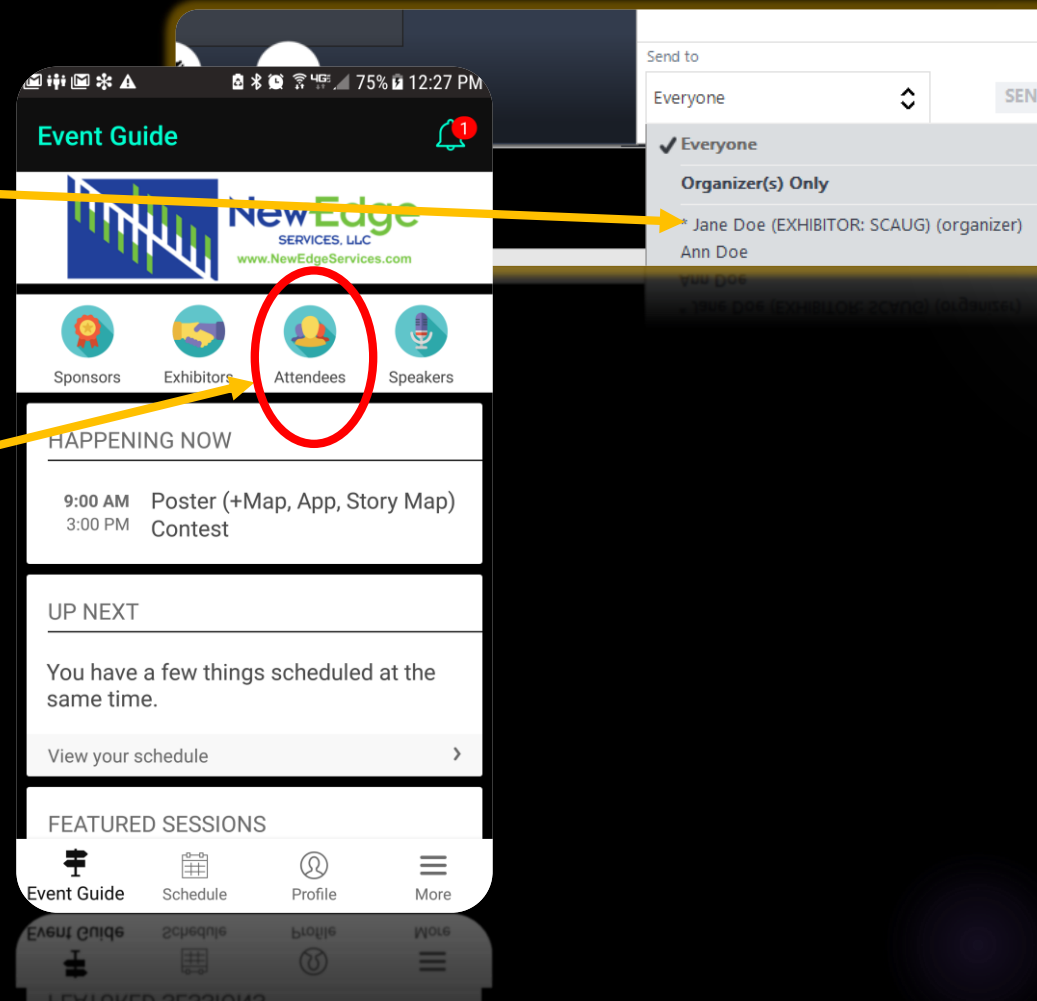

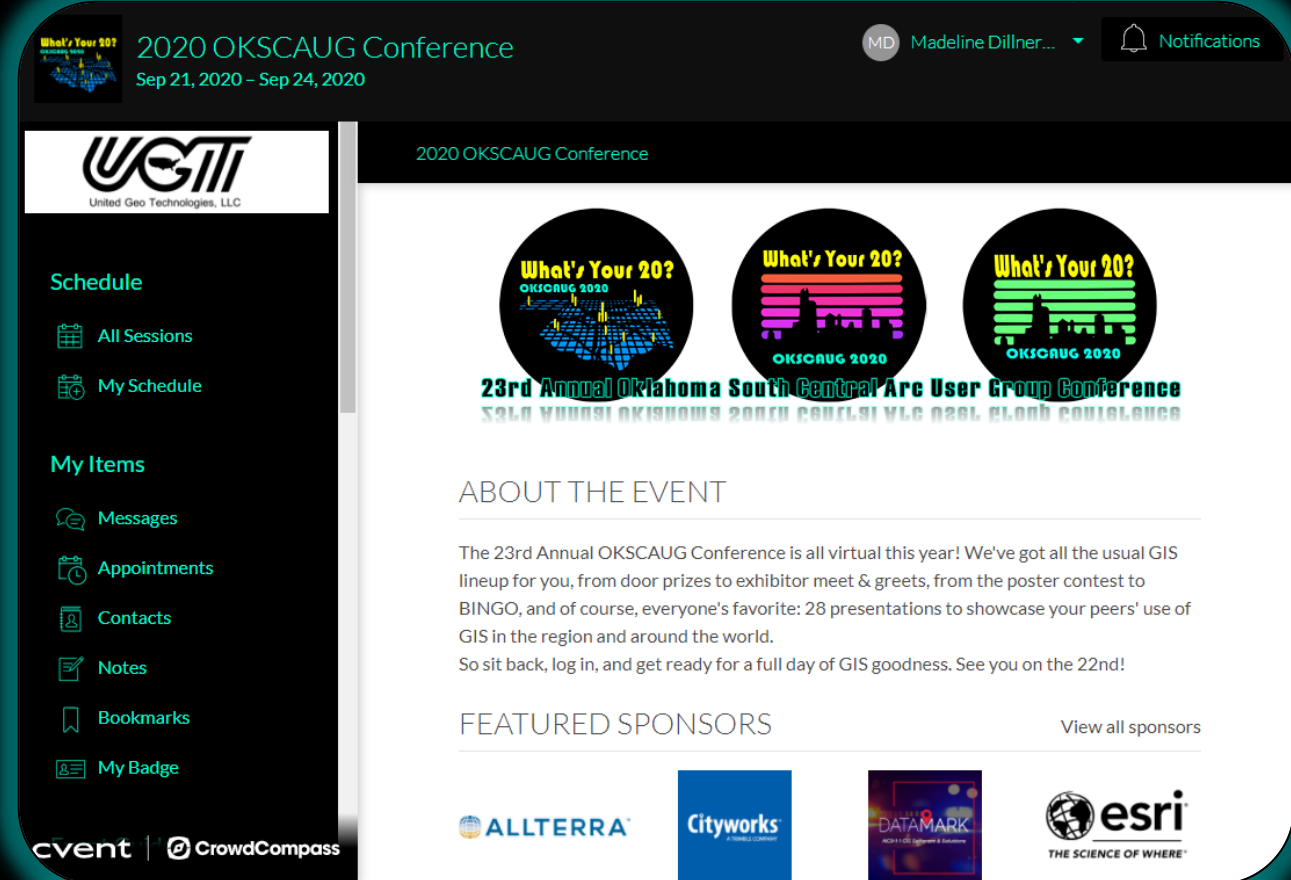

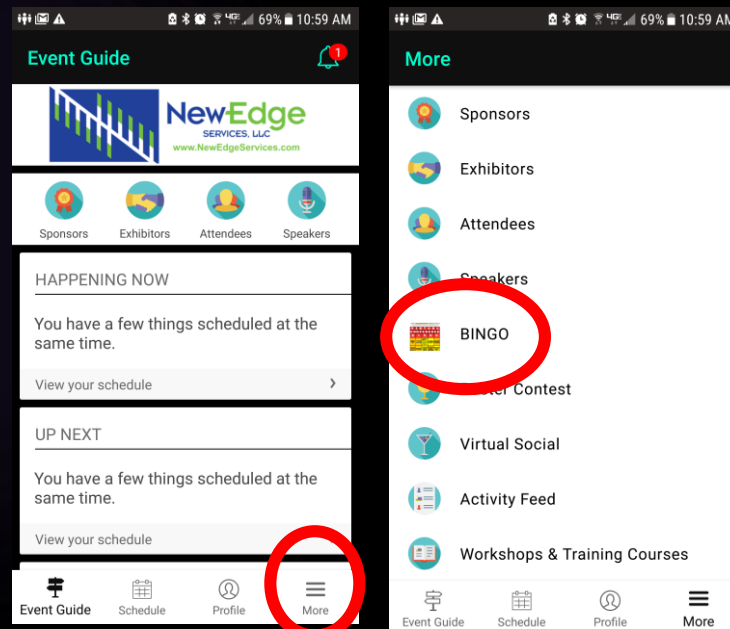
